Cornhole Game Night at the Lodge

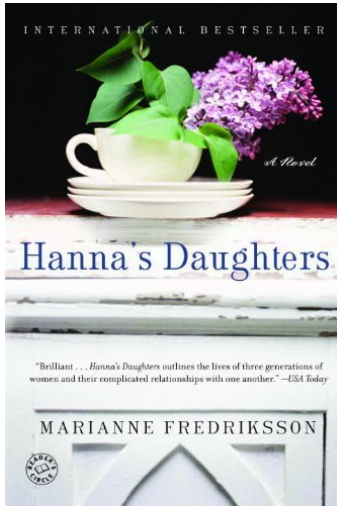

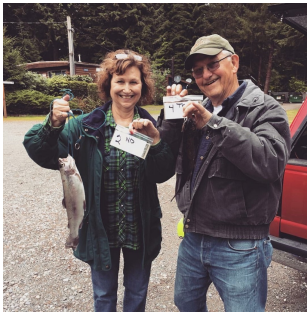

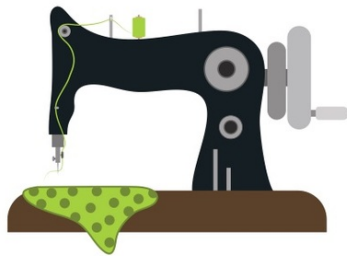
Normanna Bowling League
