Applications for Normanna Scholarships are now available in the Viking Lounge.

Scholarships are awarded each spring to children and grandchildren of members attending language camp at Lake Riley, and to high school graduates to continue their education. Normanna has sponsored the program for decades, and it has been successful. Funding is by donations. On September 25,2021 it was approved by a vote of the stockholders that every vehicle coming into the park will need to

have a hangtag on visible display. Permanent hangtags will be given to all stockholders at the February Stockholders meeting.

Normanna Lodge members when renting the log house or staying in the campgrounds will receive a temporary hang tag dated with the days of your stay.

Normanna Lodge members coming into the park will be required to purchase a yearly pass. The fee for a Yearly Pass Permit (one calendar year) which consist of one legal car occupancy is \$100. This includes parking, use of the pool, boat launch, fishing docks and restrooms.

Hangtags will not be required for Normanna Lodge sanctioned functions such as Fishing Derby, Singer's Picnic, Mid-Summerfest or other Park board approved functions.

Lifetime, golden members can receive a yearly pass as deemed by the Lodge and Park Board at no charge.
